

NOTICE OF INCREASE
COMMERCIAL IRRIGATION RATES

At its regular meeting on April 4, 2007, the Board of Directors voted unanimously to increase commercial irrigation rates (see below). The new rates will become effective May 16, 2007. Reasons for the rate increase include the impending costs to the District to convert to surface water and the increasing operation and maintenance costs. Under the Fort Bend County Subsidence District, WCID No. 2 has to convert customers from a 100% groundwater or well water supply to a combined groundwater and surface water supply. In addition, the District's water rate structure encourages water conservation, which is part of the District's Water Conservation program as approved by the TCEQ.
